## ORDINANCE NO 95/2025 OF THE RECTOR OF THE SILESIAN UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY

of 6 June 2025

## on the organisation of the academic year 2025/2026 at the Silesian University of Technology

Pursuant to Article 23 section (1) of the Act of 20 July 2018. - Law on higher education and science (consolidated text, Journal of Laws of 2025, item 1571, as amended), in accordance with § 25 section (5) of the Study Regulations constituting an attachment to the Resolution no. 6/2025 of the Senate of the Silesian University of Technology dated 25 March 2025 on the Study Regulations (Legal Monitor of the Silesian University of Technology of 2025, item 307), it is ordered as follows:

§ 1

- 1. The ceremonial inauguration of the academic year 2025/2026 will take place on 2 October 2025 at 11:00 am.
- 2. The academic year 2025/2026 comprises:
  - 1) the winter semester, including:

a) classes

01.10.2025 (odd) – 02.02.2026,

b) winter holidays

23.12.2025. - 06.01.2026, with the proviso that

- on 28.01.2026 (Wednesday, even week) classes will be held according to the odd week Tuesday schedule,
- on 30.01.2026 (Friday, even week) classes will be held according to the odd week Tuesday schedule,

c) winter examination session

03.02.2026 - 09.02.2026,

d) resit winter examination session

10.02.2026 - 22.02.2026,

e) inter-semester break

23.02.2026. – 28.02.2026,

f) semester settlement date

28.02.2026,

- subject to section (3);the summer semester, including:
  - a) classes

3. The winter semester being the last semester of the first-cycle programme shall include:

- a) on 07.01.2026 (Wednesday, odd week) classes will be held according to the odd week Tuesday schedule
- b) on 09.01.2026 (Friday, odd week) classes will be held according to the odd week Tuesday schedule
- c) on 12.01.2026 (Monday, odd week) classes will be held according to the odd week Monday schedule

2) winter break 23.12.2025 – 06.01.2026,

3) winter examination session

13.01.2026 – 19.01.2026,

20.01.2026. - 01.02.2026.

- 4. The summer semester being the last semester of the first-cycle programme includes:
  - 1) classes

02.03.2026 (odd week) - 07.06.2026; with the proviso that

- a) on 25.05.2026 (Monday, odd week) classes will be held according to the odd week Friday schedule
- b) on 26.05.2026 (Tuesday, odd week) classes will be held according to the odd week Friday schedule
- c) on 27.05.2026 (Wednesday, odd week) classes will be held according to the even week Wednesday schedule
- 2) summer examination session

08.06.2026. - 14.06.2026,

3) resit summer examination session

15.06.2026. - 30.06.2026.

- 5. Bank holidays free from classes:
  - 1) in the winter semester 1 and 11 November 2025;
  - 2) in the summer semester 1, 3 and 24 May, 4 June 2026.
- 6. Additional days free from classes:
  - 1) in the winter semester:
    - a) 2 October 2025. ceremonial inauguration of the academic year;
    - b) 2 November 2025 Rector's Day,
    - c) 10 November 2025 Rector's Day
  - 2) in the summer semester:
    - a) 2 May 2026. Rector's Day,
    - b) 6 May 2026 Sports Day,
    - c) 29 May 2026 Igry Juwenalia Gliwickie,
    - d) 5 June 2026 Rector's Day.

§ 2

- 1. For organisational and accounting purposes, it is assumed that each semester of the academic year begins with an odd-numbered week, which is the first week of the semester.
- 2. The numbering of weeks is continuous within a given semester, regardless of breaks in classes.

§ 3

- 1. The course schedules must be settled in such a way that all courses can be completed within the time period specified in §1 section (2) pt. (1a), §1 section (2), pt. (2a), §1, section (3), pt. (1), and §1, section (4), pt. (1), respectively, for courses in a given semester.
- 2. Uncompleted classes resulting from the curriculum and study plan must be completed before the beginning of the examination session.

- 1. The course instructor, in consultation with the Year Representative, shall define:
  - 1) deadlines for obtaining credits in accordance with the procedure defined in § 41 of the Study Regulations
  - 2) dates for the examination pursuant to the procedure defined in § 42 of the Study Regulations.

§ 5

- 2. It is recommended to conduct the examination on an additional date, the so-called zero date. It is recommended that a zero date be established before the examination session. The relevant provisions of the Study Regulations apply to the organisation of zero examination dates.
- 3. The course instructor or a person authorised by them shall enter the course credit and grade in USOS by the date specified in § 44 sections (2) and (3) of the Study Regulations.
- 4. In the case of students taking courses in their final semester of study, the course instructor or a person authorised by them should enter the course credit and grade in USOS immediately after the student obtains the credit and grade.

§ 6

- 1. Diploma examinations shall be conducted on dates specified in § 63 of the Study Regulations.
- 2. The Vice Dean for Education/Deputy Director for Education is obliged to ensure that first-cycle students wishing to participate in the recruitment for second-cycle studies are able to take the diploma examination within the dates:
  - 1) in the winter semester by 9 February 2026;
  - 2) in the summer semester by 13 July 2026.

§ 6

The Ordinance shall enter into force on the date of its signing, with effect from 1 October 2025.
