## on introduction of COVID-19 preventive measures in the process of education

In reference to the Regulation of the Council of Ministers of 6 May 2021 on the establishment of certain restrictions, orders and prohibitions in connection with the occurrence of an epidemic (Journal of Laws, item 861, as amended) with regard to the "Guidelines for the safe functioning of the university and other higher education and science institutions in the period of epidemic" announced by the Ministry of Education and Science:

- 1. It is kindly reminded that in the buildings of the University it is mandatory to cover the mouth and nose with a mask.
- 2. The order referred to in paragraph 1 shall not apply to students, doctoral students, participants of post-graduate programmes and other forms of education and persons conducting classes during those classes, unless otherwise decided by a person conducting classes.
- 3. If infection of a person conducting classes, a student, a doctoral student, a postgraduate student or a participant of other form of education is confirmed by a test, then an unconditional order to wear masks applies. Masks have to be worn for a period of 10 days from the date the infection was confirmed. It is obligatory for all persons attending classes with the infected person, unless quarantine/isolation is imposed by the sanitary services.
- 4. In any event, it is advised to take preventive measures to minimise the risk of infection, including the use of sanitisers and keeping a social distance.
