
WORKSHOP ON CAREER DEVELOPMENT

From RE-EURECA-PRO, the Research and Innovation dimension of the EURECA-PRO European Universities Alliance, we are pleased to invite you to participate in the Workshop on Career Development, an interesting event that will be developed on the 30th and 31st January, 2023, onsite at the University of León (Spain).





GOAL



The goal is to set a common framework to allow future synergies and push the career development of the researchers independently of the country in which they are. For that researchers coming from the 9 universities of the EURECA-PRO consortium coming from 7 different European countries (Spain, Poland, Germany, Greece, Romania, Austria, Belgium and France) are welcome.

HOW?

The participants in the workshop will discuss research career development in their own universities and countries, including merit assessments, work/life balance and gender equality, transversal skills and internationalization. All this with the purpose of identifying the best practices and proposing a common framework for the development of the research career in EURECA-PRO, which could be transferable at a European level.

EXTRA!

As an added value, the participants will come into contact with researchers from the alliance, creating potential research networks. If you are interested, University of León (ULE) will try to support the interaction with our own researchers to exchange views or be trained in case they want to prolong their stay. For this, you could request for an extension of your stay till 3rd February, 2023 (or even more days if it is agreed) to meet and work with ULE researchers.

MORE...

What researchers have to do?



- Before the Workshop. Guest researchers must gather information regarding the relevant topics that are going to be discussed during the workshop. This information must reflect their home institution's reality and if it's possible, the country's reality.
- During the debates/colloquiums, guest researchers will take an active role. We require them to give a short presentation regarding the topics selected at each session. After that, organizers will guide an open debate for all participant researchers to intervene and interact. At the end of the session will be wrapped-up.
- After the Workshop. Guest researchers could send further information they would like to share either with RE-EURECA-PRO team in ULE and other guest researchers.
- After the Workshop. Days 3, 4 & 5 (1st, 2nd, 3th February 2023). If guest researchers extend their stay to meet ULE researchers in their field. RE-EURECA-PRO in ULE will try to support the interaction with ULE researchers to exchange views, teach or be trained in case they want to prolong their stay under the Erasmus+ mobility program.

Traveling

How to fund the participation?

- We suggest using Erasmus+ mobility funds (training). Please contact your IRO for gathering the specific information.
- If guest researchers would like to prolong their stay more days to meet ULE researchers in their field, there is an option to combine Erasmus + teaching and training mobilities or using just one of them. If you have questions about it, contact your IRO.

ULE support

- The trip and the accommodation must be carried out by the participants. ULE would provide you with a list of possible accommodations.
- The researchers that decide to prolong their stay, should apply at their home institutions for the corresponding Erasmus+ funding and communicate this to the organizers so

that we can help to find links with ULE researchers.
